Senior Citizen Health Service- National Program

Kishunji Senior Citizen Health Service-National Campaign, aim to develop a model Elderly people health care program at local level. A free health camp has been organized for Elderly people of Godavari Municipality, Ward 14. Total 70 people over 80 years of age took service from the free camp. During the health camp Prime Minister Sher Bahadur Deuba inaugurated the campaign in the premises of Ex-Prime Minister of Nepal Krishna Prasad Bhattarai Foundation located at 14 Badegun, Godavari Municipality. Program was organized by Geriatric Society of Nepal in Partnership with Punyarjan Foundation and Krishna Prasad Bhattarai Foundation and the in coordination with the Government of Nepal.

As a model of the campaign, Elderly Friendly Health Club has also been set up in Badegaon at Bhattarai Ashram, and a regular health camp will also be conducted for the senior citizens of that ward on the first Saturday of every month.

In the camp, geriatricians Dr. Umesh Bogti and Dr. Anant Aryal checked the health of the senior citizens, while cardiologist Dr. Sumant Prasad Banjade, Orthopedic specialist Dr. Bhaskar Raj Pant and Dr. Prashant Adhikari conducted necessary health checks.



The camp was supported by Gerontological Nursing Rati Pakwan, Geriatric Nurse Amrita Shwari Suwal and Geriatric Physiotherapist Binita Sapkota.

The meeting nominated Dr. HomNath Chalisa and Youraj Roka from GSN to draft the senior citizen policy which includes senior citizen committee formation and mobilization guidelines and day care center operation guidelines.
